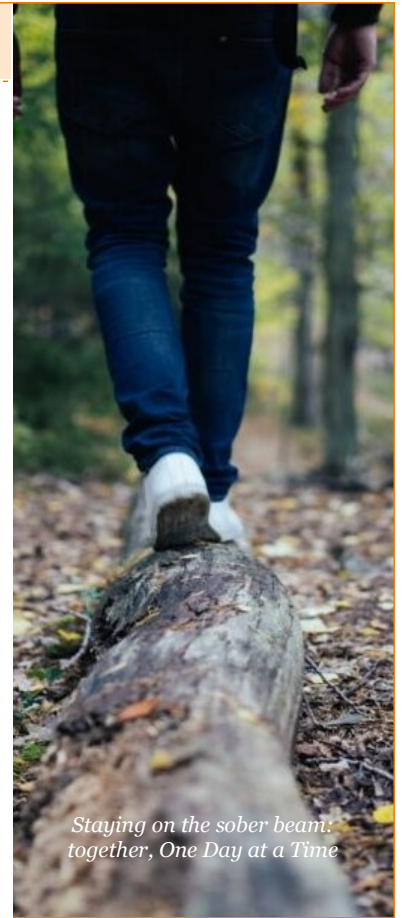
GROUP ANNOUNCEMENTS

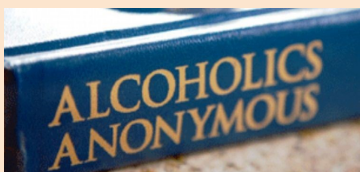

TRADITION 4—LONG FORM

“Our A.A. experience has taught us that:
